## **Sentences**

A sentence has two parts.

The subject is the person or thing that the sentence is about.

The **predicate** is the rest of the sentence.

**Subject** Predicate

The eagle is a large bird.

My bucket has a hole in it.

Rabbits live in burrows.

would like a kitten.

To find the subject of a sentence, first find the verb.

My bucket has a hole in it. verb = has

Ask who or what has in the sentence. my bucket (has a hole)

The subject is my bucket.
