Pronouns and adjectives

Some **pronouns** show ownership or **possession**.

They are called **possessive pronouns**.

This dog is **mine**.

possessive pronoun

This car is **ours**.

These are all **possessive pronouns**:

mine	yours	his	
hers	its	ours	theirs



Possessive adjectives tell us who possesses (owns) a noun.

This is **my** dog.



This is **our** car.



These are all **possessive adjectives**:

my	your	his	her	its	our	their
