Prepositions tell you **where**, **when** or **why** something happens.

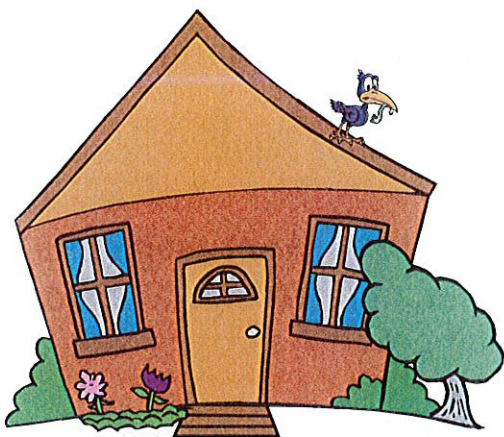
I am going **to** Sean's house **in** the morning.
