A **suffix** is a word ending.

A **suffix** added to a verb family name changes the **tense** of the verb.

verb family name	suffix <b>ed</b>	suffix <b>ing</b>	
to talk	talked	talking	
to row	rowed	rowing	
to wink	winked	winking	

Adding a **suffix** to a word can also **change the job** that word does in a sentence.

use = verb use**ful** = adjective pain = noun pain**ful** = adjective

operate = verb operation = abstract noun imagine = verb imagination = abstract noun happy = adjective happiness = abstract noun weak = adjective weakness = abstract noun

slow = adjective slow**ly** = adverb
