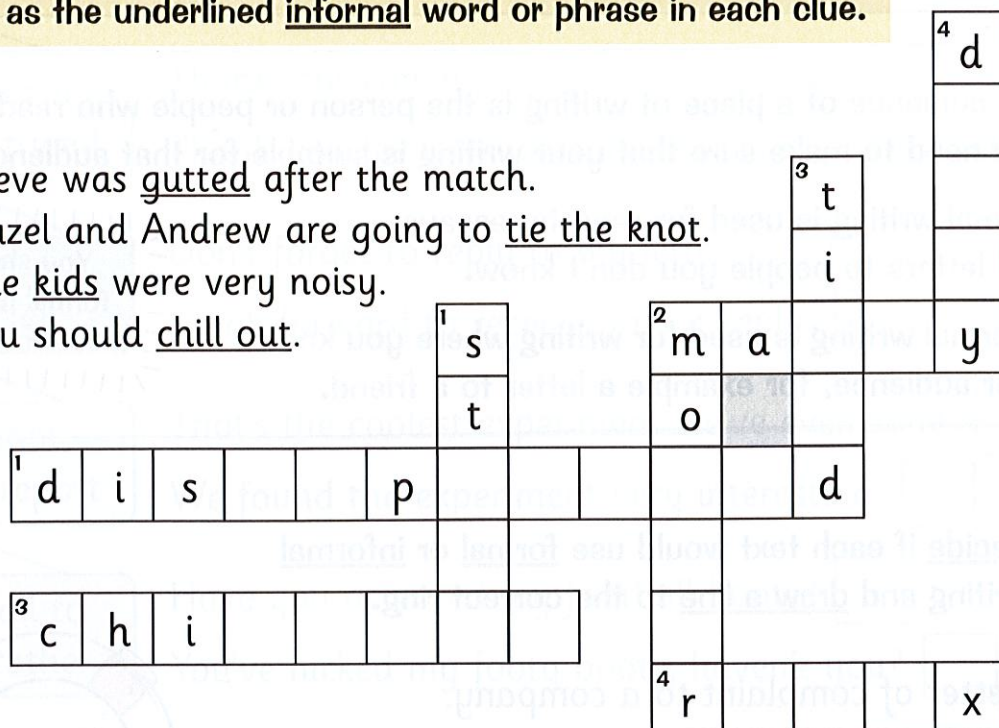


- 5 Complete the crossword by finding a **formal** word that means the **same** as the underlined **informal** word or phrase in each clue.
