Verbs tell us what happens.



This is a round-up of the verb tenses you know.

The **tense** of a verb tells us **when** something happens – in the **past**, the **present** or the **future**.

- Past simple tense
 We usually add d or ed to the verb family name.
 Hannah smiled at the baby.
 Hannah talked to her friend.
- Past progressive tense
 We use the verb to be + ing.
 Hannah was talking to her friend.
- Perfect tense
 We use the verb to have + simple past tense form.
 Hannah has talked to her friend.
- Present simple tense
 This is the verb family name. We add s for he/she and it.
 I smile at the baby. Hannah talks to her friend.
- Present progressive tense
 We use the verb to be + ing.
 You are smiling at the baby. Hannah is talking to her friend.
- Future tense
 We use the verb family name. We use shall with I and we;
 will with he/she/it/you and they.

I shall smile at the baby. Hannah will talk to her friend.
